Our association takes in unaccompanied foreign migrants for German language courses in order to facilitate their integration into society. Throughout the year they will attend courses 4 times a week which allows them to progress quickly.

In order to discover the country, we had the idea to organize a one week field trip in another town than Munich; our very fist destination was Köln in June 2017.

We decided to collaborate with the Genoveva-Gymansium and keep the educational spirit of our association by assigning to each of our 35 students a German pen pal.

During written expression classes, the UFM wrote letters to their pen pal to get to know them and talked in German with them. This pen pal activity started in the middle of September so all of them got to know each other well enough and they were comfortable when they met in June.

For one week, the UFMs will have the opportunity to discover the city through a well organized planning that you can see below.

We were staying at the Hostel "Pathpoint" which was a good location for us because it was in the city center.

With this trip in a historic town such as Köln where all the architecture is the mirror of the German culture, the UFMs had the chance to visit well known neighborhood such as the old city or the Belgian quarter, the beautiful cathedral and the Rheinpark. We also visited the neo-socialisms museum to learn more about Germany's history, they met their pen pal and attended classes with them. On the last day they had the chance to enjoy a day in the park with their pen pal.
